## HOW TO APPLY

- 1 View the information about the SHB30215 Certificate III in Makeup.
- 2 Make an appointment to discuss training options with School Vet Coordinator.
- 3 Complete the SACE application form for the SHB30215 Certificate III in Makeup email it to [applications@mediamakeup.sa.edu.au](mailto:applications@mediamakeup.sa.edu.au) with a school report and your cv.
- 4 Media Makeup will then call you to make an appointment for an interview. Arrange for a parent or guardian to attend the interview with you. Note: Vet Coordinataor must sign application form.
- 5 Download and print out the Learner's Handbook from our website. Read the Learners Handbook prior to the interview. Please bring it with you to the interview.
- 6 Prior to the interview, you will be required to arrive 15 minutes early to complete a short questionnaire. This will help us to better understand your abilities to undertake the chosen qualification that you are applying for. At the interview the content and activities of the course will be explained, policies and procedures of the academy will be discussed, any question answered and the prospective participant's ability to undertake the program will be assessed.
- 7 If accepted into the course, the participant will be enrolled and pay the course incidental expenses within 30 days of enrolment unless negotiated otherwise. Media Makeup uses a standard enrolment form, which requires the signature of both the participant and guardian. You will be invoiced for the course fees unless your school has stated otherwise.
- 8 On enrolment the participant will receive a copy of the enrolment and a receipt of payment for the deposit.
- 9 The participant is required to give a copy of the enrolment form to the Vet Coordinator.
