HOW TO APPLY

To apply for this course first you must complete the Application Form and submit the completed form. If you have left high school within the last 2 years, please provide a copy of the most recent school report. Please note that application must have all questions answered and have the relevant documents attached. Once your application has been received you will be contacted for an interview at the academy. Please download and read the Learners Handbook prior to the interview and bring it with you, as there are forms required to be completed. If you are under 18 years of age then a guardian will need to attend the interview.

Prior to the interview, you will be required to arrive 15 minutes early to complete a short questionnaire. This will help us to better understand your abilities to undertake the chosen qualification that you are applying for. At the interview the content and activities of the course and any Incidental Expenses or Fees and Charges will be explained, Policies and Procedures of the Academy will be discussed and the prospective learner's ability to undertake the course will be assessed. If accepted into the course, and a deposit is required then payment will be due at this time and then a confirmation of enrolment will be received to confirm a placement in the course.
